The 2018 DFA Reunion will be held near Washington D.C. in the Historic Town of Fredericksburg, Virginia, at the Hospitality House Hotel & Conference Center just off Rt. I-95 at Rte #3. The closest airport is Reagan National but will require either a car rental for the 50 miles on down to Fredericksburg, OR the blue line Subway to Alexandria and jumping on the Am-Track or VRE trains to Fredericksburg. OR, there is a company called “Freddy Go2 Airports” servicing Fredericksburg with transportation to or from Dulles/Richmond/ Reagan airports: at a rate of: 1 person= \$115.00; 2 persons = \$115.00 + \$20.00; 3+ persons = \$115.00 + \$20 + \$15 + 10.

The Richmond Airport is smaller and easier. You would need to rent a car on over to Fredericksburg an hour away or see the “Freddy Go2 Airports” company above at same rates.

Those East Coast members can always get the Am-Track in Boston, New York, Philly, Baltimore, and Washington and proceed on down right to Fredericksburg train station where you can get the City of Fredericksburg bus, the Fred Bus Line, to Hospitality House, or a taxi.

Those in the Midwest might as well just drive to Fredericksburg.

The Hospitality House is located in the middle of a rather new shopping district—with every chain you can think of and including a Patient First medical facility. But it is also secluded in its own little “green” area. You’ll love it. You’ll love the little historic town of Fredericksburg, too! And if you are one of those Battlefield enthusiasts you will certainly get enough of that! Or you can go for the era of George Washington, from boyhood home to visiting his mother many times.
