# 56th Biennial International Reunion

The Doane/Doan cousins will meet in Nebraska this year!

D ear Cousins,

Please join us at Doane University in Crete, Nebraska July 18-23, 2022, as we gather for our "56th" Biennial Doane Family Reunion! We hope the third time is the charm! Please go over the enclosed registration materials, and make plans to be in Nebraska in July! As you see, the schedule for our reunion week will basically follow the plan set out in our original 2020 flyer. The meetings, sessions, and activities will go on as planned. We look forward to our day-long trip to Lincoln on Wednesday July 20, however we did make an adjustment for Thursday, July 21, and we will not make the trip to Nebraska City. Instead, we will depart for Wilber, the Czech Capital of the United States, in mid afternoon rather than evening. This will allow time for an interesting session with historian/producer Mark McNutt re: the upcoming Doan Outlaws film, and a visit from a special historical figure.

By arriving in Wilber earlier than our original scheduled allowed, we will have time to explore this charming town and visit the Czech museum, library, and shops before our evening Czech dinner and entertainment. The local Czech culture had a strong influence on the ambiance of Doane University in the late 19th and early 20th centuries, and still does. Doane University even offers a Czech Scholarship to students of Czech descent. The Czechs were second only to the Germans in the list of ethnic groups who settled Nebraska, and we still boast one of the largest Czech populations in the non-urban United States. This culture is still very much alive in Nebraska. Crete's strong ethnic environment greatly affected Helen Perry Curtis (1888-1980), Thomas Doane's granddaughter. She was born and raised in Crete, and went on to become a museum professional and scholar of Eastern European culture and folk art. She is the subject of one of our sessions.

Friday's schedule will change slightly allowing more time for our memorial service, general meeting, and visits to Crete sites including the Benne Memorial Museum located right on Thomas Doane's rail line. Our DFA archival collections are stored here, and a special exhibit will be prepared for us that will incorporate many of the European costume pieces collected by Helen Perry Curtis during her travels. Perhaps you will want to visit Crete's Riverside Cemetery where our first president David B and Helen Doane Perry are buried? Other Doane University leaders are also interred there..

On July 11, 2022, Doane University celebrates her 150th birthday! We will also do some celebrating during our reunion week. Covid protocols will be in place to ensure our safety, unless the virus miraculously disappears. The University has been diligent, with success, at keeping the campus safe via indoor mask mandates, testing, and vaccination requirements and clinics. Student infections have been kept to a minimum with these procedures. We ask that all reunion attendees bring their vaccination cards, and if, for some reason, participants are not vaccinated, they should bring an official letter from their doctor, on letterhead, explaining the exemption. Please call and check with us if you have issues to discuss.

We remind you to keep your original 2020 reunion flyer for general background information on Doane University, our state, and motel options. It is so hard to predict what the future holds with this pandemic, but we are so excited to think we can all be together at last. See you this summer!
